Return To Play – Visiting Team Information Phase 2





All Visiting Teams Youth & Adult BEFORE YOU ARRIVE / PRE-GAME

Review the Langley United <u>Return To Play Phase 2</u> document, please communicate it with your players and their families.

Identify time and meeting point of the game at the location after you have reviewed the <u>Langley United</u> <u>Field Access</u> document.

No warmups or cool down (including shin pad or boot removal) is permitted on the field what so ever. Failing to adhere may result in contract revoking.

Remind your participants that:

Spectators are not allowed at any fields in the Township of Langley Complete a <u>COVID-19 symptom check</u> and remain home if there are any signs of illness. If they stay at the location they must do so in their vehicles and they must adhere to all requirements of the Langley United Return To Play document All participants must adhere to the Langley United Illness Policy

All participants must arrange to have their player meet them in a pre-determined location postgame for pick up.

Remind your players to:

Complete <u>a COVID-19 symptom check</u> and remain home if there are any signs of illness. Bring their own water bottle and hand sanitizer.

Bring something to protect their backpack/bag from the elements as bags may not be under shelter due to the requirement to have all personal belongings spread 6ft apart at all time.

Maintain social distance in meeting location and when entering the field.

Not touch any equipment outside of their personal belongings.

Remind Team Staff to:

Complete a <u>COVID-19 symptom check</u>and remain home if there are any signs of illness. Bring their own water bottle and hand sanitizer.

Bring something to protect their backpack/bag from the elements as bags may not be under shelter due to the requirement to have all personal belongings spread 6ft apart at all time.

Bring a mask (and gloves are strongly recommended) for any instance that may occur where physical distancing is not possible (i.e., injury).

Reminders for players and team staff:

It is **MANDATORY** for all team staff coaches and mangers to wear masks at all games. The mask policy will be in effect even if physical distancing can be maintained. It is **RECOMMENDED** that players walking from the vehicles to the field of play wear masks.

It is **RECOMMENDED** that players on the sideline (substitutes during games) must wear masks, until such time as they are asked to enter the field of play.

Social distancing must always be adhered to when: Entering & Exiting the field Undergoing lineup check with the referee During half time Sitting on the sidelines

Bags and personal belonging must be 6ft apart on the sidelines Players may not touch equipment at any time No spitting at any time, including during game play No team huddle, no handshakes, no fist bumps or high fives No sharing water bottles or any other personal belongings, including umbrellas Goalkeepers may not share gloves & may not spit into the gloves No throw ins, kick ins only permitted Hand sanitizing must happen every time a player comes off the field, including half time.

Sideline requirements are as follows:

Metal field benches will not be available, if using a portable bench, the bench may only have two (2) players on either end (6ft) at any time to adhere to social distancing rules. All other players must be spaced out along the sidelines 6ft apart



All Visiting Teams Youth & Adult POST-GAME

Team staff are the only ones to clean up or touch the equipment. No cool down (including removal of cleats, shin pads, etc.) permitted on the field All personnel to leave the field as required by the Langley United field access plan

All personnel are to remain socially distanced at all time post-game and while exiting the field or awaiting parent/guardian pick up from the field.
